- Stick to the topic of the respective post.
- Stick to factual information and refrain from disseminating comments or statements from unverified or anonymous sources.
- Respect copyright.
- Maintain a polite and respectful tone, even when expressing disagreement.

We reserve the right to remove comments that breach the above commenting rules and to block the commenter, if there are breaches involving the following issues:

- Incitement or any form of discrimination against groups or individuals, for example, based on gender, national or ethnic origin, religion, worldview or political affiliation, disability, age, sexual orientation or gender identity, economic and social background.
- Use of offensive language, profanity, or derogatory terms. Posting automatically or machinegenerated comments (e.g. bots)
- Insulting, pornographic, criminal, or defamatory comments/content
- Posting data worthy of protection, such as private addresses, e-mail addresses and telephone numbers or private correspondence
- Making unverifiable statements, spreading false information, and making accusations.
- Encouraging violence or illegal activities.
- Commercial posts, election, or party advertising appeals for donations, spam or calls for demonstrations.

We operate our online channels based on these simple principles and reserve the right to update these as needed to maintain a positive and productive online community.
